What is OOSH?

OOSH centre is care, play recreational based service for primary school aged children. Our service aims to provide a wide variety of supervised play activities, which assists with social. emotional, creative and physical development of children attending. Children with additional needs are included in the program. Parents will need to meet with the staff to discuss the child's transition into the service well in advance to ensure their inclusion is successful.

Hinchinbrook OOSH is located at Hinchinbrook Public School with the support of the school Principal Mrs De-Falco and the school community.

The program consists of a variety of relaxing activities such as craft, painting, dancing, drama, outdoors activities, incursion, and excursions.

Hinchinbrook OOSH offers:

Children starting kindergarten will be walked by educators to and from their classroom until they have gained enough confidence to walk on their own.

Our program offers:

DEPOSIT

A \$50.00 dollar deposit is charged prior to commencement as confirmation. This is fully refundable provided you give two weeks' notice when you decide to withdraw your child from the service. Fees are payable for school terms only, you pay for the days your child is booked into the service, regardless whether or not the child attends. Fees are payable

for public holidays during school terms.

Child Care Subsidy



To apply for the Child Care Subsidy, you will need to provide details, including:

- 1. Combined family income
- 2. Activity level of parents
- 3. Type of child care service

Subsidies to families to help with the cost of child care fees are paid directly to the child care provider. This reduces the fees families pay.
